Top 3 singles and doubles must attend the ceremony for photos

Women, Junior and Senior must choose to play in their category or open events (Same rule for Classic events). If there are less than 8 teams in the Junior/Women/Senior Doubles they can exceptionally play in the Open Doubles with the same partner. However if a Junior/Women/Senior team has chosen to play the OD category, they will not be allowed to play in the Junior/Women/Senior category. In that case with 8 teams or less, there will be no qualification for WS, WD, JS, JD, SS, SD. Format = SKO 3/5.

**Note: Junior Singles and Doubles are played on Saturday** – the Schedule and number of Qualification rounds depends on the number of players. Additionally, all male U19 Juniors are allowed to play Open Singles and all female U19 Juniors are allowed to play Women Singles on Friday ! Juniors are not allowed to play Open Doubles AND Junior Singles and Doubles. Juniors can't play Junior Classic/Nation Cup and Team Cup. U13 and U16 Kids are not allowed to take part in women or men categories. This includes also mixed, classic and dyp categories of women and men.

### REFEREE & DRESS CODE

The tournament fee includes 5€ for the Referee fees. Referee receive payment based on their level and number of matches officiated.

This fee does not guarantee a referee for all matches. There is no referring during qualification rounds. In elimination, if no referee after 10 minutes, the match must start. All Referees must wear ITSF referee shirt displaying their referee level.

Sport Dress is compulsory for ALL players during the competition including ceremonies. (Please refer to ITSF Dress Code [HERE](#) for details).

See Team Events format (page 6). Women Team Cup, Open Team Cup, Senior Team Cup and Junior Team Cup only for players non playing NTC.

### SWISS SYSTEM FORMAT

The qualifications competitions will be played under the Swiss system :

- Team Cup (See format above)
- Open Doubles, Women, Juniors and Senior
- Open Singles, Women, Junior and Seniors

(Junior Classification U19<=2002 / U16<=2005 / U13<=2008)

#### QUALIFICATION FORMAT

**Top 5 Men and top 2 Women and top 2 Senior will be seeded according to ITSF Ranking, likewise the title holder of the respective discipline**

**Seeded players/teams don't play qualifications. Seeded players can revoke their seeded place till 6 pm of the day before the competition**

**The number of the qualification matches will depend on the number of the players, the tournament progression and player performance.**

**The winner shall announce just his name (Not the score).**

**Mixed/Classic Doubles and Open/Women/Senior/Junior Singles and doubles: The Qualification match format is «Best of 3», no tie (2 points difference up to 8 maximum on the last game) only if the team / table-ratio is less than 4. Otherwise the Qualification match format is 1 to 8.**

Ranking will be based on teams points then total points of your opponent following by total points of the opponent of your opponent.

B1 stand for points of my opponent and B2 stand for points of the opponent of your opponent. If there is still a tie, we'll see the best opponent ranking that you played against.

#### ELIMINATION FORMAT

100% Players will be qualified in different divisions.

The players in the Open, Mixed, Women & Senior category will be divided into 2 brackets: Pro, Division B.

Groups ranking will be gathered and will determine the final ITSF ranking.

Open / Women /Senior/Junior U19 Single and Double:

Elimination match format is SKO 3/5 in Pro Division; SKO 2/3 in Division B. First to 5 per game (2 points difference up to 8 maximum on the last game).

Open / Women /Senior/Junior Classic U16-U19, Junior U16 Single and Double and Junior U13 Single:

Elimination match format is SKO 2/3 in Pro Division; SKO 2/3 in Division B. First to 5 per game (2 points difference up to 8 maximum on the last game).

**DELAYS: If 9 min after a game has been called, the game hasn't started and no recall has been made, both teams loose a set even if one team is present at the table. Similarly, they will lose 2 sets after 12min. Both teams will be eliminated after 15 min have passed since the match had been called and no game had started.**

Each nation can enter 2 teams for each national team competition

The 4 players are in 5 elements: Double 1 (D1), Single 1 (S1), Single 2 (S2), Double 2 (D2) and Double 3 (D3).

**Each player plays in two elements:**

- the 4 players in D1, S1 and S2 are different players.
- the same 4 players in D2 and D3.

**The match is a relay:**

- Element 1 (Double 1) plays until one of the 2 formations has 4 points.
- Element 2 (Single 1) plays until one of the 2 formations has 8 points.
- Element 3 (Single 2) plays until one of the 2 formations has 12 points.
- Element 4 (Double 2) plays until one of the 2 formations has 16 points.
- Element 5 (Double 3) plays until one of the 2 formations has 20 points (victory).

**One set per match.**

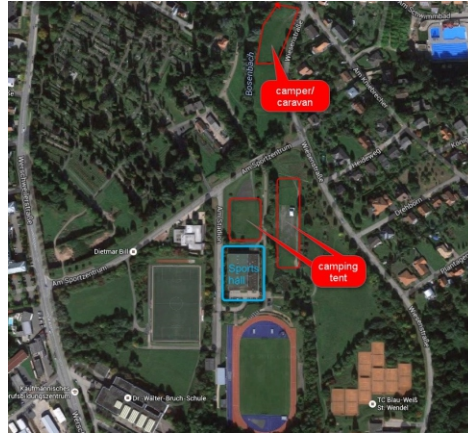
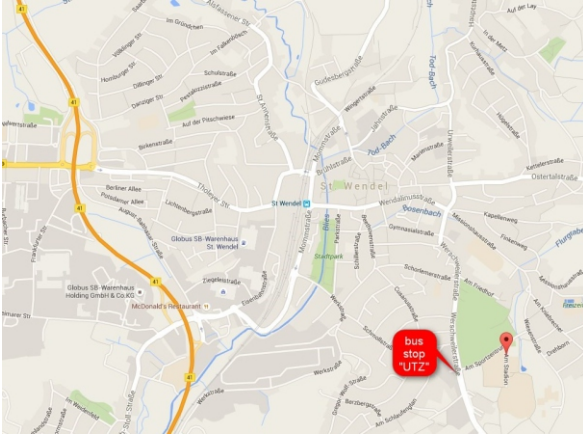
