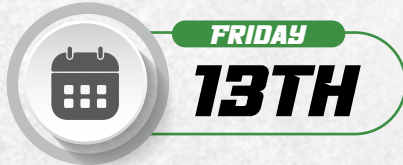

# COMPETITION FORMATS

## SWISS SYSTEM

All the qualification competitions will be played under the SWISS SYSTEM.

### QUALIFICATION

The swiss system guarantees that at least **50%** of players will qualify into the Main Division

In the qualification phase, a match will be considered as not played, if a team is not completely present at the table 10 minutes after the match is announced. A match not played may be sanctioned by disqualification by the tournament committee.

**PAIRING:** In the first round, players are paired randomly. Subsequent rounds pair players based on their current score, with efforts made to pair players with similar scores against each other

**SCORING:** Players earn points based on the results in the matches.

**AVOIDING DUPLICATE PAIRINGS:** The Swiss system avoids pairing players against each other more than once

**NUMBER OF ROUNDS:** The tournament continues for 4 rounds, with players accumulating points after each round

### CLASSIC RULES

Player figures are not allowed to rotate 360 degrees or more when advancing the ball 10 second time of possession for all rods. Goalie rods are considered one rod. The ball is served and put back into play at the goalie area unless otherwise specified by a rule.

## SEEDING

Seeded players/teams don't play qualifications.

## ELIMINATION

**100%** of players will qualify for the elimination rounds in every competition

### DELAYS:

If 9 mins after a game has been called, the game hasn't started and no recall has been made, both teams lose a set even if one team is present at the table. Similarly, they will lose 2 sets after 12 min.

**AFTER 15 MINS, BOTH TEAMS WILL BE ELIMINATED.**

## REFEREE

### **REFEERING:**

will be paid 2€ per set/team. Payment must be provided by the all players involved in the match.

There is **no** refereeing during qualification rounds.

### **ITSF RULES APPLY:**

All instructions of the tournament management must be followed.

## RULES

Players must wear proper sporting attire and are expected to uphold the highest level of personal and professional appearance.

National team players need to wear the same jersey in the national team categories. Sport Dress is compulsory for ALL players during the competition including ceremonies.

## BANS



### **SMOKING BAN:**

Smoking and vaping are absolutely prohibited for players.

**FINE: 2,50€**



### **OPEN DRINKS:**

In the area of the tournament tables, drinks may only be carried in lockable bottles, bins or other containers. This includes both players and spectators

**FINE: 10€**



### **WASTE:**

All rubbish must be disposed of in dedicated waste bins. Leaving rubbish on the ground or other areas is prohibited.

**FINE: 10€**



### **ALCOHOL:**

There is an absolute ban on alcohol in the area of the tournament tables during the competition for active players in sportswear

**FINE: 10€**
